



Lueck Files for Reelection

(Aitkin, MN) Representative Dale Lueck filed for reelection to the Minnesota House of Representatives at the Aitkin County Court House on Tuesday morning May 24th. Back in the district the day after the legislature adjourned in Saint Paul, Lueck stopped by the Auditor's office to file on his way to visit with the Aitkin County Board. Lueck represents House District 10B, which includes all of Aitkin County and a large portion of rural Crow Wing County. Lueck is the Republican endorsed candidate for House District 10B.

Rep. Lueck said, "We got a lot done for the district during the 89th Session, but we still have work to do on a statewide capital investment bonding and a long term transportation package." Lueck added, "My parents taught me to finish what you start. While we were able to strengthen the financial viability of our rural nursing homes, allow our county probation officers to remain within the Community Corrections Act program, reduced the onerous state general property tax, increased the rural broadband program, made progress in upgrading the Cuyuna Country State Recreation area and put in place an aid package for the Mille Lacs Lake area, there is more to be done."

Lueck is vice-chair of the House Mining and Outdoor Recreation Committee and is a member of the Agriculture Finance, Agriculture Policy, Lands Subcommittee and Veterans Affairs Committee. He also serves on the Legislative Permanent School Fund Commission and the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board.

"Serving the citizens of Aitkin and Crow Wing County is a privilege and I would be honored should the citizens decide to allow me to continue that service." Lueck said. "Eliminating the tax on our senior's social security retirement benefits, fixing our roads and bridges, providing support for our group homes for the disabled and in homecare professionals, and continuing to improve our business climate in rural Minnesota are just a few of the items that I will continue to work on."

Dale and wife Linda have two grown children & five grandchildren. Dale graduated from Aitkin Public High School in 1967. While serving in the US Navy earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Occupation Health & Safety and a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. After 28 years of service Dale retired from the US Navy in 1997. Dale and Linda currently raise beef cattle on their 340-acre farm in Aitkin County.
