

## **Lueck Endorsed by GOP for Reelection**



(Aitkin, MN) Representative Dale Lueck (10B) received a unanimous endorsement by Aitkin County and Crow County Republican delegates for his reelection to a third term in the Minnesota House of Representatives. Delegates gathered at the Journey North Community Church in Aitkin on Saturday morning March 3<sup>rd</sup> for the endorsement process.

Rep. Lueck is in his fourth year representing House District 10B, which encompasses all of Aitkin County and a large portion of Crow Wing County, stretching from the Cities of Manhattan Beach to Fort Ripley and east to the Aitkin County line. Lueck currently serves as Vice-chair of the House Mining, Forestry and Tourism Subcommittee, and is a member of the House Environmental and Natural Resources Policy and Finance Committee, Ag Policy Committee, Capital Investment Committee, Veterans Committee and Chair of the Legislative Permanent School Trust Commission.

After the unanimous vote conferring the endorsement Lueck said, “Thank you for your overwhelming vote of confidence, my wife Linda and I are honored by your continued support for service in the legislature. I will continue to fight the good fight on behalf of our district, I will faithfully represent the values and viewpoints we collectively hold here in District 10B.”

The endorsing process begins with Minnesota House candidates and will continue on with a GOP endorsing convention on May 5<sup>th</sup> for US Congressional District Eight at Park Rapids. Delegates will endorse a Republican candidate to run for the open seat in US Congressional District Eight. Then on June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Minnesota Republicans will gather in Duluth to endorse candidates for statewide races including; governor, attorney general, secretary of state, state auditor and both US Senate seats.

Dale and wife Linda have been married 48 years, they have two grown children, five grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Dale graduated from Aitkin Public High School in 1967. While serving in the US Navy he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Occupation Health & Safety and a Bachelor’s Degree in Business Administration. After 28 years of active duty service Dale retired from the US Navy in 1997. Dale and Linda currently raise beef cattle on their 340-acre farm in Aitkin County.
